

**Sullivan's Pond Concert Series |****Aug. 10 – Sept. 1**

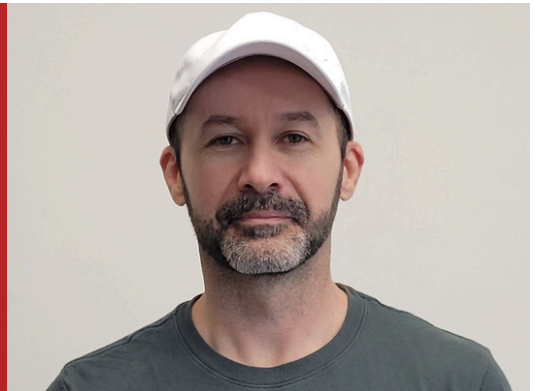
